3. The aim of these tasks is to induce learning, you are requested not to put/ take any undue pressure by trying to achieve 'perfection' or trying to finish off the assignments. Use the "one step at a time" approach & attempt the tasks "one by one".
4. Parents must establish a set time each day for reading and writing practice.
5. Give revision of oral syllabus, phonetic sounds & general awareness questions attached with the home assignment.
6. Craft activities involve cutting & pasting work and cannot be done without the use of scissors/glue. It is therefore advisable that children should undertake all craft activities under parental guidance.
7. Creativity of the child knows no boundaries, please feel free to experiment with new ideas/ways of doing things.

LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT

ENGLISH

ORAL:

- Learn five lines on 'MYSELF'
- Revise all the rhymes(with gestures) done in the class.
- Speak in simple English with your child.
- Help your child memorize home address, phone no. and date of birth.
- Narrate simple stories to your child, ask to recall some characters & incidents of the story by asking simple questions related to the story.

MATHEMATICAL DEVELOPMENT

ORAL :

- Learn oral counting 1 to 10

NUMER BOX:

- Take a shoe box or any box , decorate it with coloured paper. Collect articles/ pictures that symbolises numbers 1 to 10 e.g. 1 pencil, 2 pebbles, 1 sun, 2 eyes 1 bottle cap, 2 ice-cream sticks, 3 buttons, 5 rubber-bands etc., put all the materials in the shoe box.

WRITTEN:

- Practice writing numbers 1 to 4 (5 times) for each number.
- Make cut outs of different shapes (circle, square, and triangle) from old newspapers & magazines and paste them in the scrapbook.

KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD

GREEN DRIVE:

- **Plant a sapling:** Explain to your child that plants also have life & discuss how do they grow and what is required for their growth.

Steps for germination:

- Take a pot.
- Fill it with soil and manure.
- Sow the seeds (seasonal plant/ flower)
- Water it daily & see it grow into a plant.

NOTE : 1) Kindly send the sapling to school after summer break

2) Click the pictures of the child while nurturing the plant & paste it in the scrapbook (2 pictures)

- Make decorative flashcards of Animals & their young ones using pictures.
- Draw pictures of any five animals, leaving one on two parts missing. Ask the child to draw the missing part.

FINE MOTOR DEVELOPMENT

Let your child indulge in activities like mashing potatoes, rolling chapatties, clay moulding, sand play, free hand painting shelling out peas etc.

Mix a handful of Rajma & Chana and ask your child to separate it using tweezers or with hands.

Take some old newspapers, cut them into suitable size & ask the child to do scribbling. Send at least 10 sheets to the school.

Note : Capture the memories & paste in the scrapbook (2 pictures at least).

CREATIVE DEVELOPMENT

FACE MASK: Help your child to make any one animal face mask.

SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

- Spend quality time with your child. Play games like Ludo, Carrom Board, Snakes & Ladder, Scrabble etc.
- Have at least two meals together and tell them not to waste their food.
- Inculcate sharing habits, good manners and respect in your child.
- Encourage your child to use magical words like Please, Sorry, Thank you, Excuse me, Welcome, Good morning & Good night.
- Teach your child about personal hygiene.
- Go for shopping together. Tell your child about difference between market & mall, about the things/ items and materials purchased from these places.

- Regular visit to grocery shop, fruit & vegetable shop will help them to make independent choice of fruits & vegetables they would like to eat. Click at least two pictures and paste in the scrapbook.
- **Memory game:** Put a few things in a tray, show the tray to your child for a while then cover the tray, ask your child to name the objects which were on the tray. Try putting different objects/ items on different days.

PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- Encourage your child to play outdoor games like throw & catch the ball cricket, skipping rope and any other outdoor game of their choice.
- Encourage him/her, jump & play on the swings in the park.

LIFE SKILLS

Make your child independent. Encourage him/her to:

- Keeps toys back in their place.
- Zipping & unzipping.
- Packing his/her school bag.
- Tying his/her shoe laces.
- Opens & close water bottles, lunch box.

- Buttoning his/her shirt.
- Take bath independently.
- Tell your child about “Good touch and Bad touch”.
